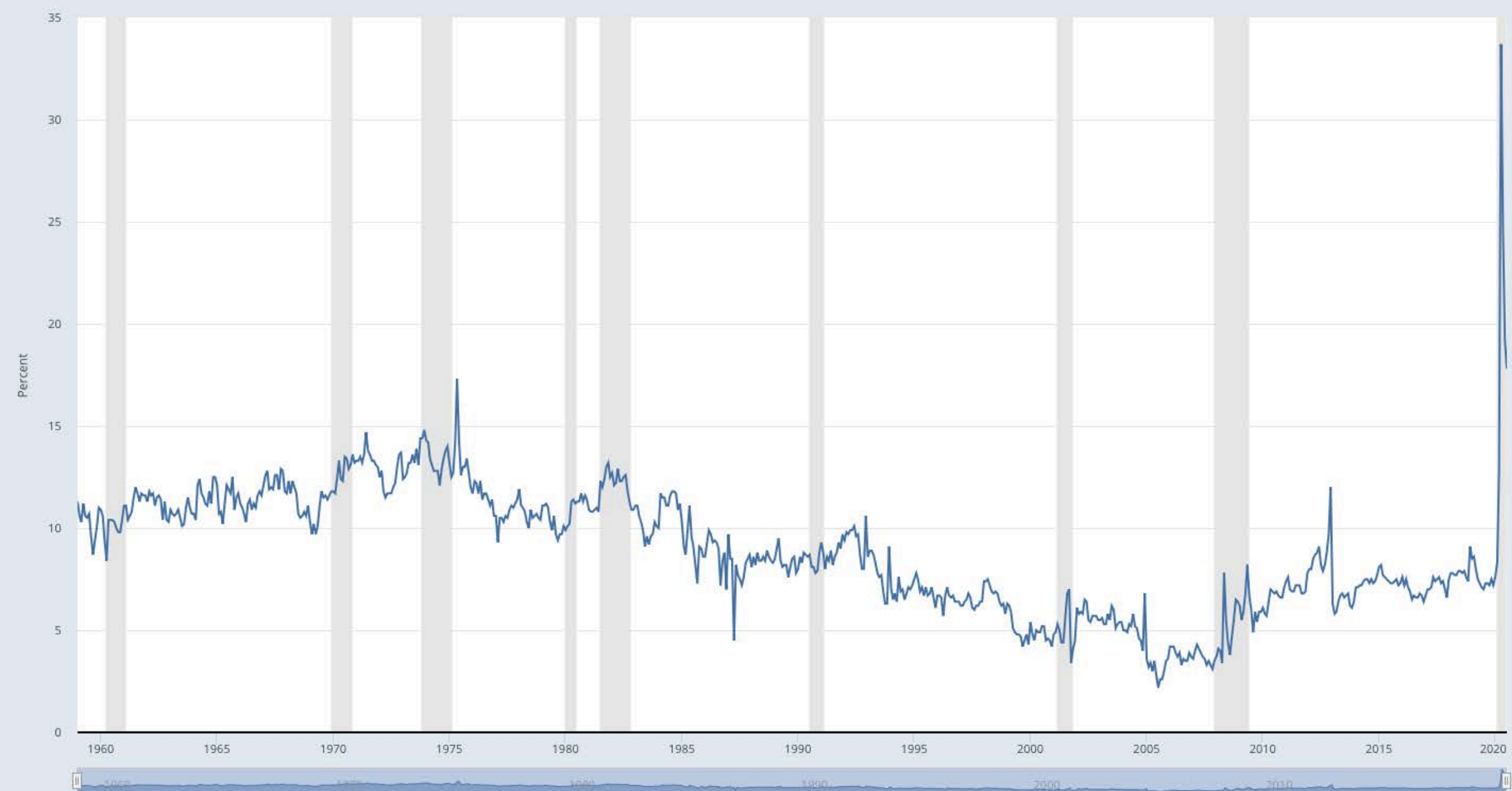

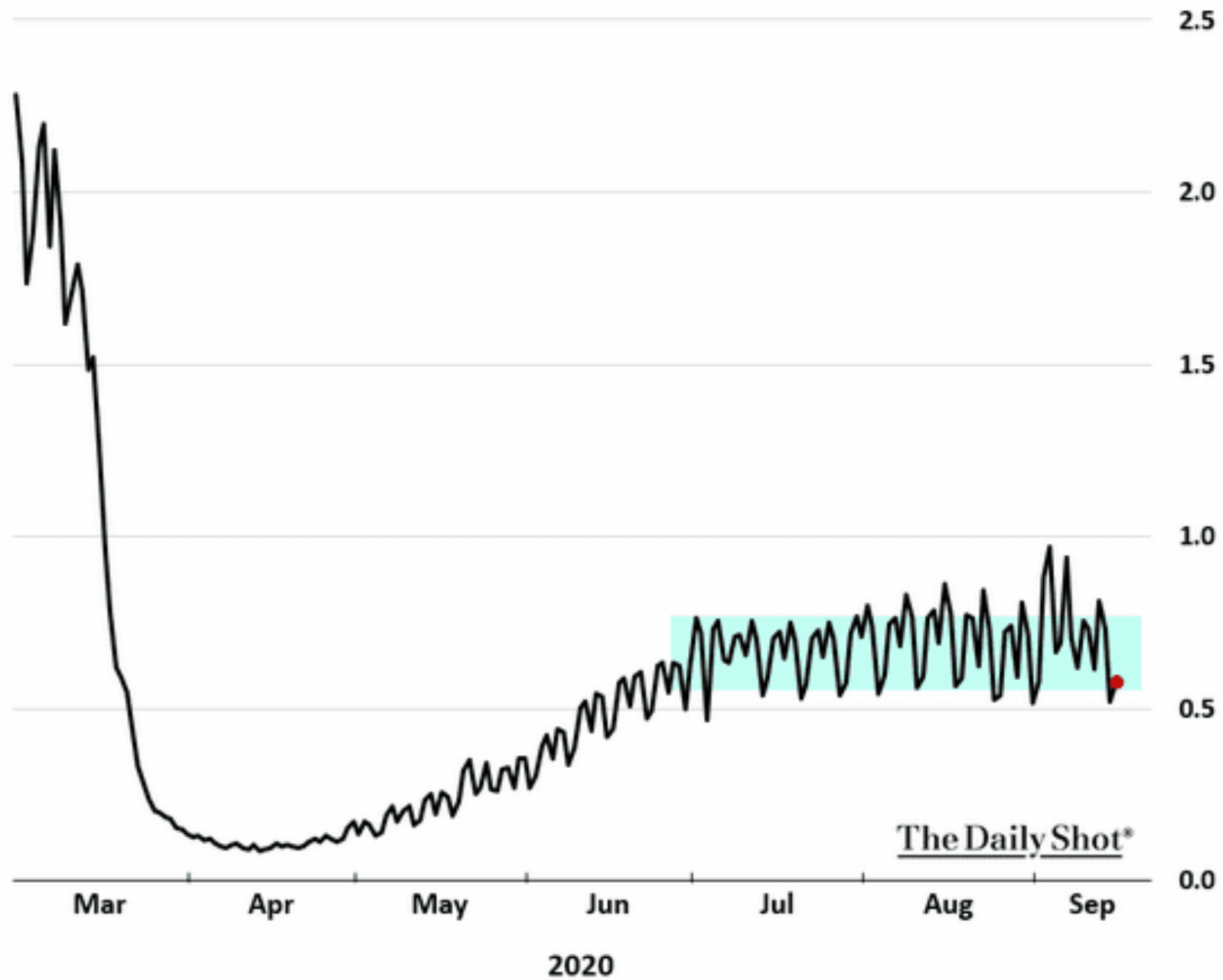

U.S. credit- and debit-card spending, change from a year earlier

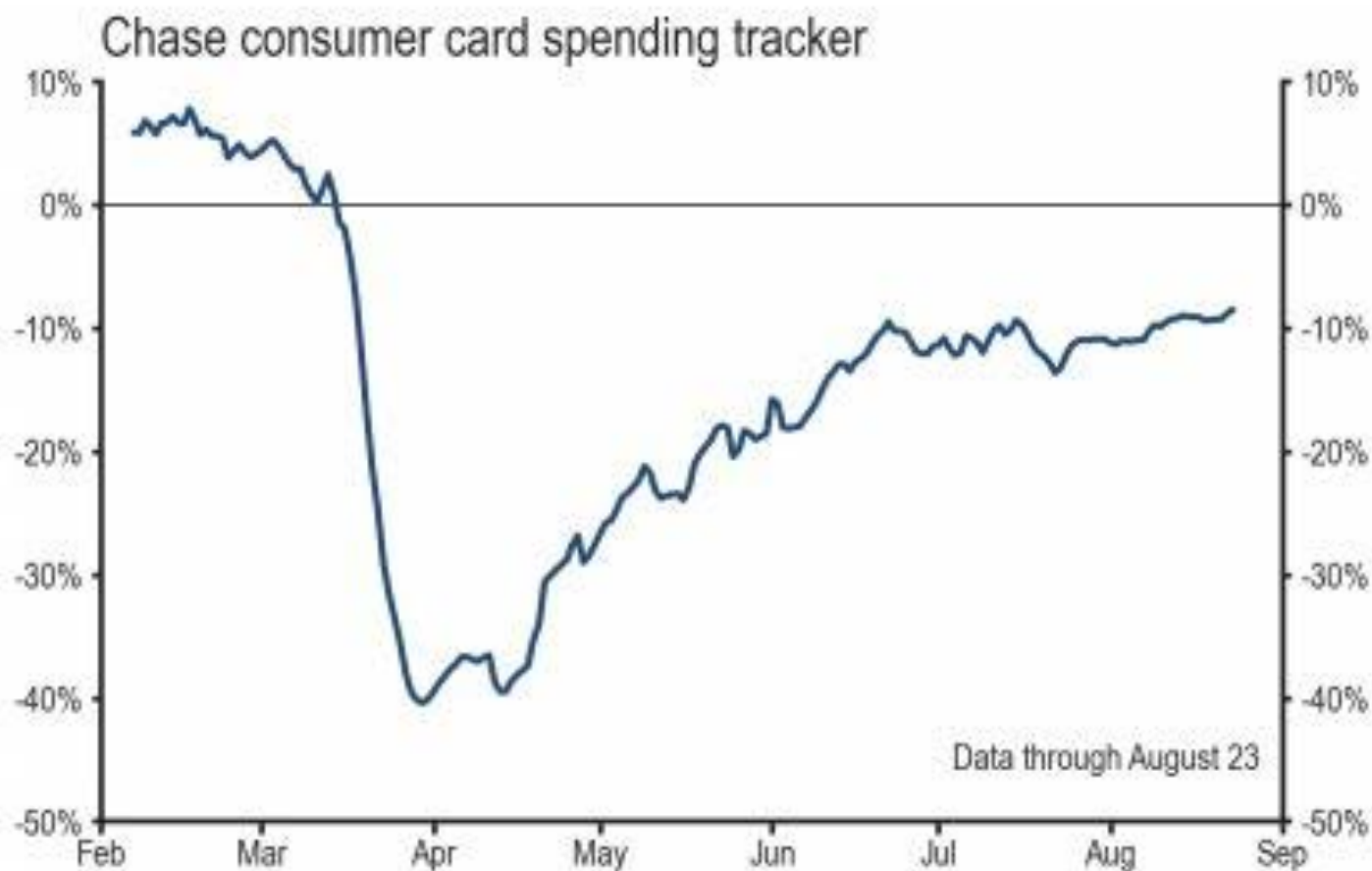

- On August 23, our tracker of Chase consumer card spending rose from -8.8% to -8.5%.
- The tracker rose 0.6%-pt over the prior week, and it is 31.9%-pt above its low of -40.4% on March 30.
